£15 supermarket vouchers have been scheduled for the October holiday for all pupils eligible for income-related Free School Meals.

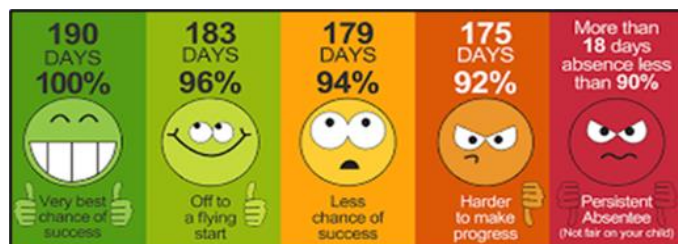
