Mr Carron, our sports coach, ensures our Y1 and Y2 children get lots of exercise and have fun with friends through structured games during the lunch hour.

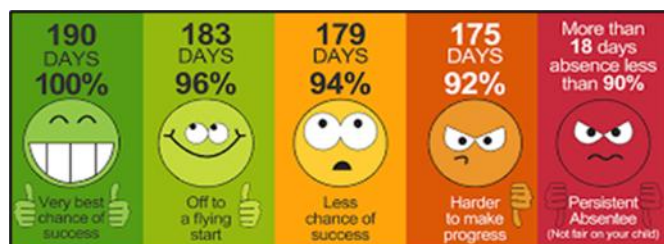
