**T**he school hall was ablaze with symbols of the gifts of the Holy Spirit on Tuesday when parents and carers joined the children for Stay-and-Pray.

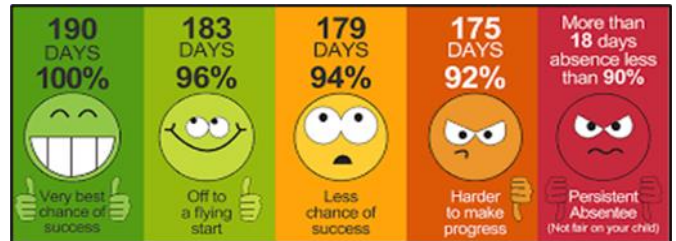


**M**rs Watson's sewing club has created the sweetest decorative lavender bags: perfect for the sock drawer.
