As a family, you are invited for one evening to participate in this little festive tradition of reflecting on the message, meaning and miracle of Christmas.



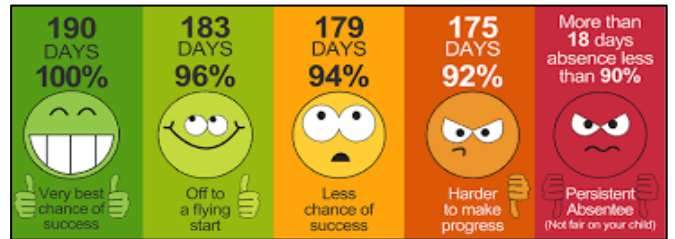
On Monday, we will welcome-back Mrs Manson following her Maternity Leave.
