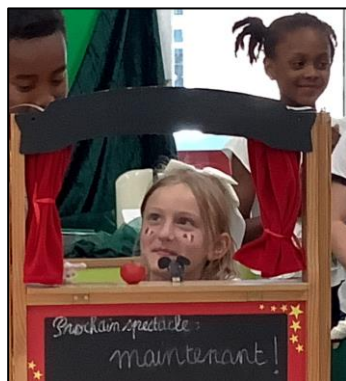


Supermarket vouchers will be issued for pupils eligible for Free School Meals (including current Y6 pupils) during the six weeks Summer Holidays on:

17th July, 31st July and 14th August.

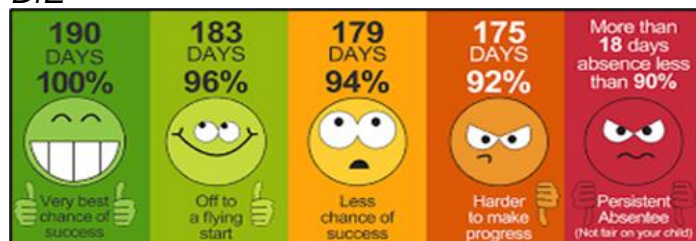
