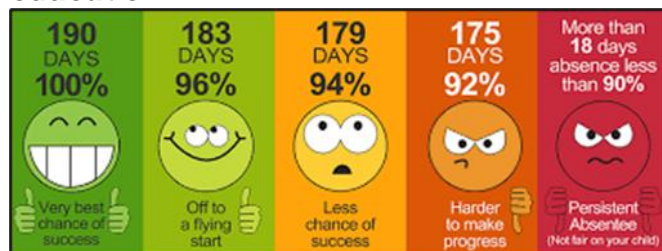
Well done!
