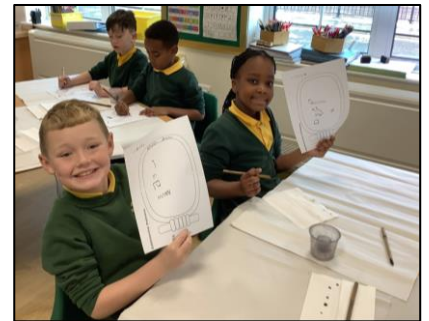

Reception parents and carers joined the children at Stay-and-Play on Monday afternoon. The session focused on the sound 'e': as in 'excellent work everyone!'

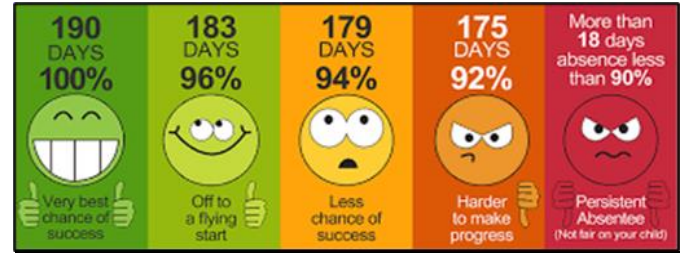
