Our After-School Dance Class is ready for 'Strictly'! Their sharp lines, slick kicks and powerful poses would score a full-house of 10s. Encore!

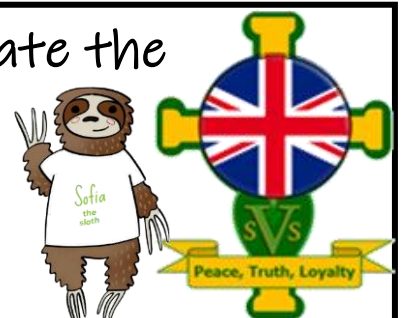

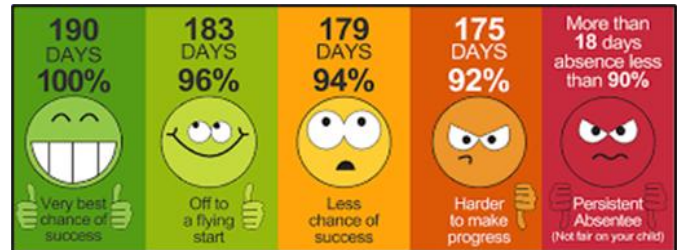
